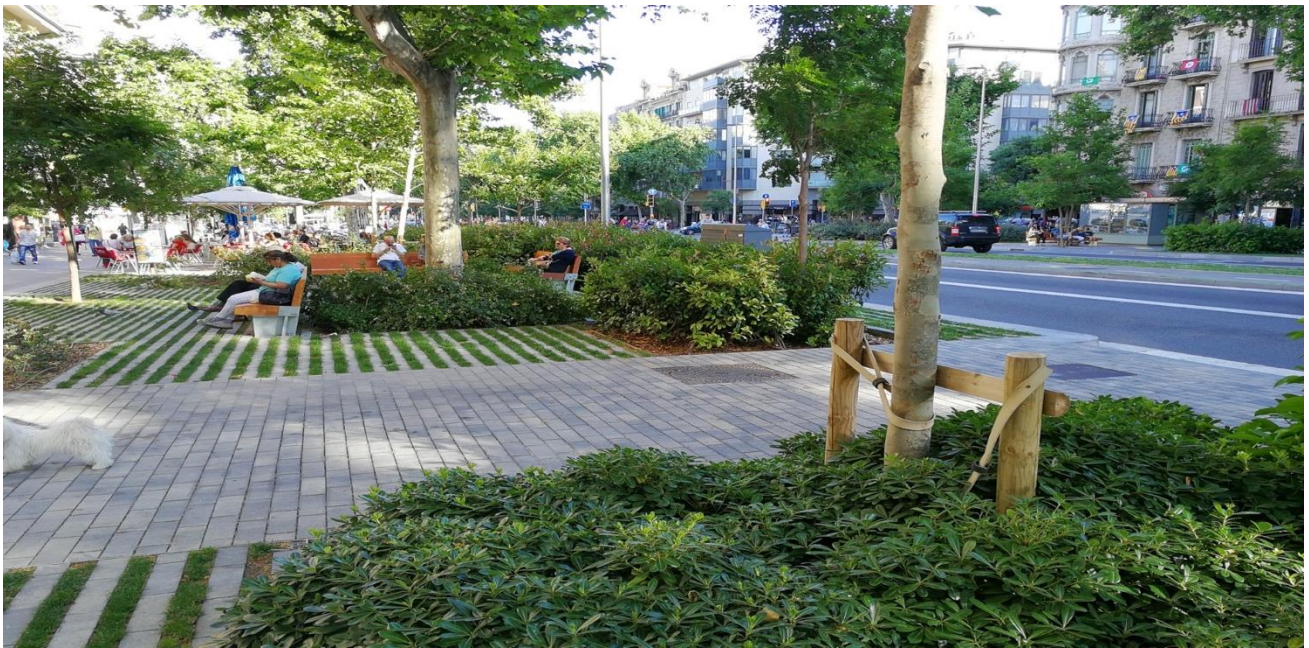


BARCELONA: GREEN CORRIDOR

There is recognition of direct and experienced ecosystem service benefits of nature-based solutions; however they can be in conflict with ecological and sustainability priorities



Early civil participation is key for future civil engagement in the implementation of nature-based solutions
